The app contains information for 1,530 coastal accessways, displayed on colorful base maps, with details on the physical setting, facilities, and visitor activities - such as sandy beaches or tide pools, disabled facilities and wheelchair accessible trails, restrooms and parking, campgrounds, trails and visitor centers.
