

Searching for a Record by Parcel number

Each county has a unique 5-digit code (called a FIPS code) and parcel formatting scheme (for example, some counties use hyphens and some don't) to differentiate their respective parcel numbers from each other. Counties may have the same parcel number in their data, however, using the FIPS code allows the user to find the correct parcel number for each county. Below is a guide illustrating the FIPS code for each county and how their respective parcel data is formatted. When searching for a parcel number in a specific county, use the specific FIPS code and format for the parcel number as illustrated in the Example APN Number column below.
