ENGINEERING GEOLOGIST OR SENIOR ENGINEERING GEOLOGIST

The California Coastal Commission (Commission) is offering an exciting opportunity for an individual knowledgeable in engineering geology and interested in applying science to public policy decisions. The Commission is a small State agency that is charged with protecting coastal resources and managing coastal development in California. The mission of the Commission is to implement the Coastal Act and to provide for the balanced use of the coastal zone and to protect, restore, and enhance coastal and marine resources for the continuing benefit of current and future generations.

The duties of this position will include the following:

- Perform a broad range of complex geologic staff work concerning present and future environmental policies. Will work closely with the Commission's Senior Coastal Engineer.
- Serve as the Commission's in-house geologist providing advice to staff in all Commission offices on a wide range of terrestrial and marine geologic and earth science issues. Assist staff in permit application review and Local Coastal Program (LCP) policy review.
- Represent the Commission on important statewide committees and technical advisory groups dealing with issues such as geologic hazard identification and mitigation, slope stability and site development, regional planning, resource protection and climate change.
- Develop staff recommendations to the Commission and other agencies on a wide variety of projects, policies and issues affecting geologic resources within the coastal zone.
- Serve in a variety of forums as a spokesperson for science-based implementation of the CA Coastal Act.
- Provide training to Commission staff and local governments on a wide variety of geologic issues.
- Work closely with a multi-disciplinary team of Coastal Commission staff members on a variety of coastal issues.

***Duties will be commensurate with the classification at which an applicant is appointed.**

Desired Qualifications: Training and experience in geology, engineering geology, earth science geology and coastal processes. Engineering and/or geologist license and Master's Degree or Ph.D. are strongly preferred.

ELIGIBILITY: Individuals on the Engineering Geologist or Senior Engineering Geologist eligible lists may apply. Current state employees or former state employees with transfer or reinstatement rights at the Engineering Geologist or Senior Engineering Geologist level may also apply. (Please note that in order to be eligible to transfer or reinstatement, applicants must meet the minimum qualifications of the Engineering Geologist or Senior Engineering Geologist classification.) Appointment is subject to the State Restrictions of Appointment (SROA) provisions. Applicants must clearly indicate the basis of their

eligibility, including SROA, surplus, transfer, re-employment status, or list eligibility in the Examination or Title section on the State Application Form 678.
