

## Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) in the Coastal Zone

## **General Information**

- ADUs and JADUs can provide additional, lower-cost housing opportunities in many types of neighborhoods.
- · Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) can be detached or attached to a house.
- Junior ADUs (JADUs) are separate living spaces built inside an existing home.

The California Coastal Zone is the **1%** of California closest to the shoreline. In 90% of the Coastal Zone, ADUs are permitted by local governments. In the remaining 10%, ADUs are permitted by the Coastal Commission.
