

#### Overview of Invoicing and Progress Reports

- Submit Invoices and Progress Reports using LCP Grant Request for Funds Form and Progress Report Template
- □ Request for Funds (RFF) and Progress Reports due quarterly
  - Submit RFF and supporting documentation (including subcontractor invoices) in triplicate
- RFFs and Progress Reports Due:
  - End of October (for work completed in July, August, September)
  - End of January (for work completed in October, November, December)
  - End of April (for work completed in January, February, March)
  - End of July (for work completed in April, May, June)
- Payment takes 45 days from date we receive hardcopies
- Funds will be provided on a reimbursement basis
