These permits ensure projects meet the Coastal Act, which protects public access to beaches and other shorelines across California.

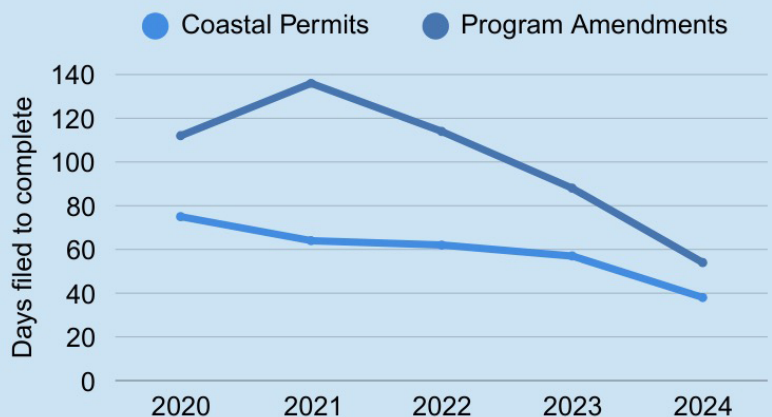


86% of Coastal Commission decisions in 2024 were expedited through waivers, consent agendas and other means.

were appealed to the Coastal Commission in 2024. Only a single project was denied.
