

Vineyard Offshore: Our Approach



- Communicate and engage early, often, and transparently.
- Prioritize aligning project design with local community needs.
- Develop strong working relationships with tribal partners, organized labor, fisheries, and environmental communities.
- Seek opportunities to provide direct, tangible benefits to the local workforce, including strong union jobs, training and apprenticeship programs, partnerships with higher education, and supply chain opportunities for small businesses.
- Goal - avoid potential impacts to the greatest extent possible through siting and design measures.
- Use data, research, and stakeholder feedback to identify mitigation measures.

Humboldt: Vineyard Offshore – Current Status & Next Steps

- Awaiting on BOEM to execute the lease.
- Working with Magellan Wind, our local development partners, to advance the project locally – and will be transitioning the project fully to the Vineyard Offshore team.
- Initial engagements with Tribal Nations and stakeholders by Senior Management to introduce Vineyard Offshore and begin relationship building.
- Expanding internal and external teams in California to continue early-stage Tribal, community, and agency engagement.
- Planning listening sessions with the Humboldt area community, as well as with key regional and state leaders.
- Initiating technical due diligence, preliminary site assessments, and reviewing transmission, procurement, and port infrastructure needs.
