

WHEREAS, the City Council directed staff to complete the work program identified in the SOLA Strategy including the General Plan, Local Coastal Program (LCP) amendments and associated rezonings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing on February 27, 1996 and approved the General Plan/LCP amendments and rezonings necessary to achieve consistency with the General Plan and the SOLA Strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Coastal Commission considered Amendment 1-96 including the SOLA amendments at its meeting of June 13, 1996 and directed the City Council to formalize amendments to the City's Local Coastal Program, to maintain consistency between the LCP and the Zoning Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santa Cruz that the LCP amendments shall be adopted as indicated in Exhibit "A", and forwarded to the Coastal Commission for final certification.


