RE: SANTA BARBARA COUNTY LCP AMENDMENT 1-96 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DETERMINATION THAT THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT IS LEGALLY ADEQUATE. (For Commission review at its meeting of December 10-13, 1996.)

On October 8, 1996 the Commission approved LCP Amendment 1-96 submitted by the County of Santa Barbara with suggested modifications. This amendment would:

1) amend specific permit procedures and clarify and update text provisions; 2) establish new ordinance procedures regarding non-conforming uses and structures, and allow modification to zone district requirements; 3) clarify the intent of the ordinance and provide consistency between Article I and II; and 4) provide other minor clarifications and text amendments.

On November 19, 1996, the County of Santa Barbara acknowledged receipt of the Commission's resolution for LCP Amendment 1-96 and transmitted the acknowledgement to the Commission on November 20, 1996. In its acknowledgement the County of Santa Barbara accepted the Commission's action and agreed to issue coastal Development Permits in conformance with the Commission's resolution.

As provided for in section 13544.5 of the Commission's Administrative Regulations, the Executive Director must determine if the action of the County of Santa Barbara is legally sufficient and report that determination to the Commission. The certification shall become effective unless a majority of the Commission objects to the determination.

I have reviewed the County of Santa Barbara's acknowledgement adopted November 19, 1996 regarding LCP amendment 1-96 and find that it fulfills the conditions of certification of the Santa Barbara County Local Coastal Program, and that the County's action and notification procedures for appealable development legally satisfies the Commission's certification resolution adopted October 9, 1996. I therefore recommend that the Commission concur in this determination.
