SUBJECT: CAPITOLA CITY LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM NO 1-96: Proposed Minor Amendment to the certified Implementation Plan Zoning Ordinance to Deregulate Small Satellite Dishes to be heard at the Commission meeting of January 7-10, 1997 at the Crown Plaza - Holiday Inn LAX, 5985 West Century Blvd., Los Angeles; 1-(310) 642-7500

The City of Capitola is requesting that its zoning ordinance be amended. This amendment request was filed on November 22, 1996 pursuant to Section 30510(b) of the Coastal Act and Sections 13553 and 13555 of the California Code of Regulations. The purpose of this notice is to advise interested parties of the determination by the Executive Director pursuant to Section 13555 of the California Code of Regulations that the proposed amendment is minor as defined in Section 13554.

Summary of Amendment: Modifieds Section 17.63.030 to the Capitola Zoning Ordinance to exempt small satellite dishes, 24 inches in diameter or less and no more than 24 inches in height from the site and architectural review process. The complete text of the proposed amendments are available at the Commission's office in Santa Cruz.

The amendment does not change the kind, location, intensity or density of use and does not modify resource protection standards and is consistent with the Land Use Plan as certified by the Commission. Under provisions of Section 13554 of the Commission Regulations, the Executive Director has determined these amendments are "minor".

Pursuant to Section 13555, the Executive Director will report this determination to the Coastal Commission at its January 7-10, 1997 at the Crown Plaza - Holiday Inn LAX, 5985 West Century Blvd., Los Angeles. The Executive Director will also report any objections to the determination that are received within ten days of posting of this notice. The proposed minor amendments will be deemed approved and will become effective immediately unless one-third of the appointed members of the Commission request that they be processed as major amendments.

ORDINANCE NO. 794

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAPITOLA, AMENDING CHAPTER 17.63 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING SATELLITE DISH ANTENNAE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAPITOLA HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 17.63.030 of the Municipal Code, Architectural SECTION 1. and Site Review Ordinance, shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 17.63.030 Required when. Site plan and architectural review is required for the following uses:

- Any dish-type antenna which is larger than twenty-four (24) F. inches in diameter, except the following:
 - Those, located in a rear or side yard which are: (a) not visible either from the public right-of-way upon which the property fronts; or (b) not visible from the ground level of the adjacent properties.
 - Those located upon flat roofs which: (a) do not exceed twenty-four (24) inches in height above the roof and have no dimension which exceeds twenty-four (24) inches;
 - Those located on sloping roofs where: (a) no part of which 3. exceeds the height of the highest part of the roof, and (b) no dimension of which exceed twenty-four (24) inches;
 - 4. Those entirely prohibited by Section 17.81.140.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect thirty days after its final adoption or upon approval by the California Coastal Commission, whichever occurs last.
