

SUBJECT: Public Hearing and action on request for a period not to exceed one year for Commission action on proposed LCP Amendment 2-97 A, B, and C to: (A) amend the Greewell Park/Preserve in the Summerland Planning Area; (B) Amend the Goleta Transportation Improvement Plan; and (C) amend the Ellwood Beach – Santa Barbara Shores Specific Plan/Monorach Point Reserve Project in the Goleta Planning Area of the County of Santa Barbara.

Pursuant to Section 30512 of the Coastal Act, an LCP Land Use Plan amendment must be acted on by the Commission within 90 days of a complete submittal. In order to be heard within the allotted time period, the amendment would have to be scheduled for the Commission's October 1997 meeting.

Section 30517 of the Coastal Act and Section 13535(c) of the California Code of Regulations provides that the Commission may extend for good cause the 90 day time limit for a period not to exceed one year. Commission staff is requesting this extension in order to fully analyze the amendment submittal. The County of Santa Barbara has been contacted and does not object to the extension request.

<u>STAFF RECOMMENDATION</u>: Staff recommends that the Commission extend the 90 daytime limit to act on Santa Barbara County's Local Coastal Program Amendment 2-97 for a period not to exceed one year.

MOTION:

I move that the Commission extend the 90 day time limit to act on the Local Coastal Program amendment 2-97 for a period not to exceed one year.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends a <u>YES</u> vote. An affirmative vote of a majority of the Commissioners present is needed to pass the motion.
