SUBJECT: Interagency Agreement with the San Francisco Bay  
Conservation and Development Commission  
(For the meeting of November 4, 1997, in San Diego)

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Commission authorize the Executive Director to enter into an interagency agreement to transfer up to \$23,000 to the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission for assistance in implementing a boater education program.

Staff Analysis: In May 1997, the Coastal Commission was awarded a grant from the Integrated Waste Management Board to conduct the Boating Clean and Green Campaign, a three-year educational effort. The goal of the campaign is to reduce the emission of oil and other pollutants associated with boating. The campaign will provide educational outreach to boaters and work with local governments and marine businesses to facilitate the installation of pollution reduction services. The project will target three regions: the San Francisco Bay and Delta areas, the greater Los Angeles region and the San Diego area.

Under the terms of this Interagency Agreement, the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission would provide the Coastal Commission with professional and technical services to assist in the implementation of the Boating Clean and Green Campaign over the three year project period. As compensation for this assistance, the Coastal Commission would pay BCDC a sum not to exceed \$23,000 over three years.
