EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DETERMINATION AND REPORT FOR COMMISSION  
REVIEW AT THE MEETING OF MAY 13 - 16, 1997

Background

On February 6, 1997, the Commission concurred with the determination of the Executive Director that this amendment is a minor amendment, pursuant to California code of Regulations section 13555, thereby approving the amendment as submitted. The amendment included incorporation of elements of the Front Street Enhancement Plan along portions of Front street in the community of Avila Beach. On March 28, 1997, the Board of Supervisors acknowledged receipt of the Commission's assent to the determination of the amendment as minor and its approval as submitted.

Recommendation

Pursuant to Section 13544 of the California Code of Regulations, the Executive Director must determine that the action of the County of San Luis Obispo is legally adequate and report that determination to the Commission. It is recommended that the Commission concur with the determination of the Executive Director that the action of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo acknowledging the determination that the amendment is a minor amendment pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 13555, and the Commission's assent thereto, is legally adequate.
