**SUBJECT:** Request to extend the 60 day time limit for Commission action on Manhattan Beach LCP Amendment Request No. 2-97. For public hearing and Commission action at the July 8-11, 1997 meeting in Ventura.

On May 13, 1997 the South Coast District staff received LCP Amendment Request No. 2-97 from the City of Manhattan Beach. The submittal was deemed incomplete and additional information and materials were requested. On June 2, 1997, the City submitted the requested materials and information and the amendment submittal was deemed complete pursuant to the requirements of Section 30510(b) of the Coastal Act.

Pursuant to Section 30513 of the Coastal Act, an LCP amendment affecting the implementing ordinances (LIP) portions of the LCP must be acted on by the Commission within sixty days of complete submittal. In order to be heard within the allotted time period, the amendment would have to be scheduled for Commission hearing at the current July 8-11, 1997 meeting. The City of Manhattan Beach has requested that the public hearing and action be scheduled for the August 12-15, 1997 meeting in Los Angeles (Exhibit #1).

Section 30517 of the Coastal Act allows the Commission to extend, for good cause, the sixty day time limit for a period not to exceed one year. Commission staff is requesting this extension in order to allow the public hearing and action on the LCP amendment request to be scheduled for the Commission's August 1997 meeting as requested by the City.

**Staff Recommendation:** Staff recommends that the Commission extend the sixty day time limit for a period not to exceed one year.
