Coastal Conservancy Meeting, February 1998

The Conservancy met in Sacramento on February 19 and took the following actions:

- 1. Discussed priorities for the Habitat Conservation Fund and the status of Hamilton Field and San Francisco Bay dredging.
- 2. Approved the Port of San Francisco Pier 98 Public Access and Wetlands Enhancement Plan, and authorized funding for its implementation.
- 3. Authorized (a) its Executive Officer to enter into a feasibility cost sharing agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for the Hamilton Field Wetlands Restoration project; (b) the acceptance of funds from the Marin Community Foundation and others; and (c) the disbursement of these funds for the project.
- 4. Authorized funding: (a) to San Luis Obispo County for construction of a vertical accessway in the unincorporated area of Cayucos; (b) to the City of Petaluma for construction of a bridge and trail over and along Lynch Creek; (c) to the Sinkyone Wilderness InterTribal Council for development of a public access plan for the InterTribal Sinkyone Wilderness Park, in Mendocino County; and (d) to the People for Open Space/Greenbelt Alliance to assist in the determination of priorities for public recreation and open-space goals for the San Francisco Bay region.
- 5. Adopted a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program to include contracting policies and goals for projects funded by the U.S. Department of Transportation.
- 6. The next Conservancy meeting will be held on March 24, 1998, in Monterey.
