RE: CITY OF SANTA BARBARA LCP AMENDMENT 3-97 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DETERMINATION THAT THE CITY"S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT IS LEGALLY ADEQUATE. (For Commission review at its meeting of September 8-11, 1998.)

On June 9, 1998, the Commission approved LCP Amendment 3-97 submitted by the City of Santa Barbara with suggested modifications. This amendment would add a circulation element to the City of Santa Barbara's certified Local Coastal Program.

On July 21, 1998 the City of Santa Barbara acknowledged receipt of the Commission's resolution for LCP Amendment 3-97, agreed to accept all suggested modifications, and transmitted the acknowledgement to the Commission on August 3, 1998. In its acknowledgement the City of Santa Barbara accepted the Commission's action and agreed to issue Coastal Development Permits in conformance with the Commission's resolution.

As provided for in section 13544.5 of the Commission's Administrative Regulations, the Executive Director must determine if the action of the City of Santa Barbara is legally sufficient and report that determination to the Commission. The certification shall become effective unless a majority of the Commission objects to the determination.

I have reviewed the City of Santa Barbara's acknowledgement adopted July 21. 1998 regarding LCP amendment 3-97 and find that it fulfills the conditions of certification of the City of Santa Barbara's Local Coastal Program, and that the City's action and notification procedures for appealable development legally satisfies the Commission's certification resolution adopted July 21, 1998. I therefore recommend that the Commission concur in this determination.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION RESOLUTION OF CERTIFICATION FOR LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM LAND USE PLAN AMENDMENT 3-97 RELATED TO THE 1997 CIRCULATION ELEMENT OF THE GENERAL PLAN

WHEREAS, on November 11, 1997 the City Council held a noticed public hearing concerning the adoption of the 1997 Circulation Element and considered recommendations from the public, Consensus Group members, the Planning Commission, and information contained in Staff reports; and

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the City Council adopted Resolution 97-143 incorporating the 1997 Circulation Element and related Local Coastal Program Amendment into the City's General Plan contingent upon certification by the California Coastal Commission; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 1998 the Coastal Commission approved Amendment 3-97 to the City of Santa Barbara Local Coastal Program Land Use Plan with suggested modifications; and

WHEREAS, on July 9, 1998, the Planning Commission revieweld the Coastal Commission's suggested modifications and recommended that the Council accept the modifications;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA:
