COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA LCP AMENDMENT 2-98-A EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DETERMINATION THAT THE COUNTY'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT IS LEGALLY ADEQUATE.

(For Commission review at its meeting of April 13-16, 1999)

On December 8, 1998, the Commission approved LCP Amendment 2-98-A submitted by the City of Santa Barbara as submitted. This amendment would make miscellaneous changes to the administrative regulations and zone requirements of the implementation component of the County's certified Local Coastal Program.

On February 9, 1999, the County of Santa Barbara acknowledged receipt of the Commission's resolution and transmitted the acknowledgement to the Commission on March 10, 1999. In its acknowledgement, the County agreed to accept the Commission's action, and agreed to issue Coastal Development Permits in conformance with the Commission's resolution.

Pursuant to Sections 13551(b) and 13544 of the Commission's Administrative Regulations, the Executive Director must determine if the action of the County of Santa Barbara is legally sufficient and report that determination to the Commission. The certification shall be come effective unless a majority of the Commissioners object to the determination.

I have reviewed the County's acknowledgement adopted February 9, 1999 regarding LCP Amendment 2-98-A and find that it fulfills the conditions of the Commission's action to certify Amendment 2-98-A, and that the County's action and notification procedures for appealable development legally satisfy the Commission's certification resolution adopted December 8, 1998. I therefore recommend that the Commission concur in this determination.
