CITY OF SANTA BARBARA LCP AMENDMENT 3-98 A & B CERTIFICATION REVIEW AND EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DETERMINATION THAT THE CITY'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT IS LEGALLY ADEQUATE. (For Commission review at its meeting

of September 14-17, 1999)

On April 15, 1999, the Commission approved LCP Amendment 3-98 A & B as submitted by the City of Santa Barbara. This amendment incorporated Harbor Master Plan Design Guidelines and Airport Architectural and Urban Design Guidelines into the City's certified Local Coastal Program.

On August 3, 1999, the City of Santa Barbara acknowledged receipt of the Commission's resolution for LCP Amendment 3-98 A & B and transmitted the acknowledgement to the Commission on August 11, 1999. In its acknowledgement, the City agreed to accept the Commission's action, and agreed to issue Coastal Development Permits in conformance with the Commission's resolution.

Pursuant to Sections 13551(b) and 13544 of the Commission's Administrative Regulations, the Executive Director must determine if the action of the City of Santa Barbara is legally sufficient and report that determination to the Commission. The certification shall become effective unless a majority of the Commissioners object to the determination.

The Executive Director has reviewed the City's acknowledgement adopted August 3, 1999 regarding LCP Amendment 3-98 A & B and find that it fulfills the conditions of the Commission's action to certify Amendment 3-98 A & B, and that the City's action and notification procedures for appealable development legally satisfy the Commission's certification resolution adopted April 15, 1999. Staff therefore recommend that the Commission concur in this determination.

WHEREAS, on September 1, 1998, the City Council held a noticed public hearing and considered adoption of the revised Airport Architectural and Urban Design Guidelines including recommendations from the public, the Architectural Board of Review, the Airport Commission, the Planning Commission, and information contained in the staff report; and

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the City Council adopted Resolution 98-115 adopting the revised Airport Architectural and Urban Design Guidelines, contingent upon certification by the California Coastal Commission; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 1999, the Coastal Commission approved Amendment 3-98A and 3098B to the City of Santa Barbara Local Coastal Program Implementation Measures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA:

Acknowledges receipt of and accepts the California Coastal Commission's Resolution of Certification of the Amendment to the Local Coastal Program Implementation Measures revising the Harbor Master Plan Design Guidelines and the Airport Architectural and Urban Design Guidelines.
