STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Pursuant to section 30621 of the Coastal Act, an appeal must be heard within 49 days from the date an appeal of a coastal development permit issued pursuant to a certified Local Coastal Program was filed. The appeal of this County permit was filed on September 12, 2000; the 49th day therefore falls on October 31, 2000, after the Commission's October meeting, but before the Commission's November meeting. Therefore, staff recommends that the Commission open and continue the public hearing. The appeal will be tentatively scheduled for a substantial issue hearing at the Commission's November meeting in Los Angeles.
