SUBJECT: Memorandum of Agreement with the California State Parks Foundation (For the meeting of March 14, 2000, in Monterey.)

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Commission authorize the Executive Director to amend its Memorandum of Agreement with the California State Parks Foundation, to accept up to an additional $\$ 5,000$ for personnel expenses for the Adopt-A-Beach Program.

Motion: I move that the Commission authorize the Executive Director to amend its Memorandum of Agreement with the California State Parks Foundation to accept up to an additional $\$ 5,000$ for personnel expenses for the Adopt-A-Beach Program.

Staff Analysis: The California Coastal Commission coordinates the Adopt-A-Beach Program in partnership with the California State Parks Foundation (CSPF). The CSPF serves as the fiscal agent for the Adopt-A-Beach Program. The Adopt-A-Beach Program is a statewide educational campaign to promote coastal conservation, recycling and litter reduction. The Program includes California Coastal Cleanup Day, an annual one day event that in 1999 drew over 45,000 volunteers to clean California beaches, lakefronts, and waterways; the Year Round Adopt-A-Beach Program, in which groups pledge to clean a particular beach three times over the course of a year; and the Save Our Seas Kindergarten to grade 12 ocean pollution curriculum.

The original agreement was for $\$ 15,000$, to employ a program assistant for the Adopt-ABeach Program. The purpose of this amendment is to add up to $\$ 5,000$ to the original agreement to extend the timeframe for employing the program assistant.
