RE: COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA LCP AMENDMENT 2-98-B (GOLETA OLD TOWN REVITALIZATION PLAN) EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DETERMINATION THAT THE COUNTY'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT IS LEGALLY ADEQUATE. (For Commission review at its meeting of April 11-14, 2000)

On February 4, 1999, the Commission approved LCP Amendment 2-98-B submitted by the City of Santa Barbara as submitted. This amendment would incorporate the Goleta Old Town Revitalization Plan, including land use plan and implementation measures, as submitted into the County's certified Local Coastal Program.

On February 15, 2000, the County of Santa Barbara acknowledged receipt of the Commission's resolution and transmitted the acknowledgement to the Commission on March 13, 2000. In its acknowledgement, the County agreed to accept the Commission's action, and agreed to issue Coastal Development Permits in conformance with the Commission's resolution.

Pursuant to Sections 13551(b) and 13544 of the Commission's Administrative Regulations, the Executive Director must determine if the action of the County of Santa Barbara is legally sufficient and report that determination to the Commission. The certification shall be come effective unless a majority of the Commissioners object to the determination.

I have reviewed the County's acknowledgement adopted February 15, 2000 regarding LCP Amendment 2-98-B and find that it fulfills the conditions of the Commission's action to certify Amendment 2-98-B, and that the County's action and notification procedures for appealable development legally satisfy the Commission's certification resolution adopted February 4, 1999. I therefore recommend that the Commission concur in this determination.
