(Antiquated Subdivision Ordinance) EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S
DETERMINATION THAT THE COUNTY'S
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT IS LEGALLY ADEQUATE. (For
Commission review at its meeting of July 11-14, 2000)

On July 7, 1998, the Commission approved LCP Amendment 1-97-C submitted by the County of Santa Barbara as submitted. This amendment rescinds the antiquated subdivision ordinance that had previously been incorporated into the County's certified Local Coastal Program.

On May 16, 2000, the County of Santa Barbara acknowledged receipt of the Commission's resolution and transmitted the acknowledgement to the Commission on June 2, 2000. In its acknowledgement, the County agreed to accept the Commission's action, and agreed to issue Coastal Development Permits in conformance with the Commission's resolution.

Pursuant to Sections 13551(b) and 13544 of the Commission's Administrative Regulations, the Executive Director must determine if the action of the County of Santa Barbara is legally sufficient and report that determination to the Commission. The certification shall be come effective unless a majority of the Commissioners object to the determination.

I have reviewed the County's acknowledgement adopted May 16, 2000 regarding LCP Amendment 1-97-C and find that it fulfills the conditions of the Commission's action to certify Amendment 1-97-C, and that the County's action and notification procedures for appealable development legally satisfy the Commission's certification resolution adopted May 16, 2000. I therefore recommend that the Commission concur in this determination.


