Staff recommends that the Commission concur with the Executive Director's determination that the City's action is legally adequate.


### BACKGROUND

On June 14, 2001, the Coastal Commission certified Local Coastal Program Amendment 3-99 (Coastal Element) with suggested modifications. This Local Coastal Program Amendment affected both the certified Land Use Plan (Coastal Element) and certified Implementation Program. The land use portion of the LCP amendment was approved with suggested modifications. The implementation portion (Zoning District Maps) was approved by the Commission as submitted. The effect of this LCP amendment was the replacement of the Coastal Element in its entirety and the deletion of twenty Zoning District Maps outside the coastal zone from the City's LCP.

On September 4, 2001, the City of Huntington Beach accepted, and agreed to the Commission's suggested modifications to the Coastal Element by passing Resolutions No. 2001-57 and 2001-58 incorporating the Commission's suggested modifications into the City's certified Local Coastal Program.

As provided for in Section 13544 of the California Code of Regulations, the Executive Director must determine that the City's action is legally adequate and report that determination to the Commission. In this case, the Executive Director has determined that the City's action is legally adequate. Unless the Commission objects to the Executive Director's determination, the certification of the Local Coastal Program Amendment 3-99 (Coastal Element) shall become effective upon the filing of the required notice of certification with the Secretary of Resources as provided in Public Resources Code Section 21080.5(d)(2)(V).

Said suggested modifications shall be certified and become effective pursuant to Section 13544.5 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations on the date when the following two conditions have been met:

- i. Commission concurrence with the Executive Director's determination that the City's action is legally adequate; and
- ii. The Notice of Certification has been filed with the Secretary of Resources.

2. That the City Council certifies that the amended Local Coastal Program is intended to be carried out in a manner in full conformance with the California Coastal Act.
