### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

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Pursuant to section 30621 of the Coastal Act, an appeal must be heard within 49 days from the date an appeal of a coastal development permit issued pursuant to a certified Local Coastal Program was filed. The appeal of this County permit was filed on 2/21/01; the 49th day therefore falls on 4/11/01, after the Commission's March meeting, but during the Commission's April meeting. Therefore, staff recommends that the Commission open and continue the public hearing. The appeal will be tentatively scheduled for a substantial issue hearing at the Commission's April meeting in Santa Barbara or the May meeting in Santa Cruz.
