(Lot Size Compliance and Lot Line Adjustment Program)  
EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DETERMINATION THAT THE  
COUNTY'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT IS LEGALLY ADEQUATE. (For  
Commission review at its meeting of July 10-13, 2000.)

On April 12, 2001, the Commission approved LCP Amendment MAJ-1-100 submitted by the County of Santa Barbara with modifications.

On June 5, 2001, the County of Santa Barbara acknowledged receipt of the Commission's resolution and transmitted the acknowledgement to the Commission on June 12, 2001. In its acknowledgement, the County agreed to accept the Commission's action, and agreed to issue Coastal Development Permits in conformance with the Commission's resolution.

Pursuant to Sections 13551(b) and 13544 of the Commission's Administrative Regulations, the Executive Director must determine if the action of the County of Santa Barbara is legally sufficient and report that determination to the Commission. The certification shall be come effective unless a majority of the Commissioners object to the determination.

I have reviewed the County's acknowledgement adopted June 5, 2001 regarding LCP Amendment MAJ-1-00 and find that it fulfills the conditions of the Commission's action to certify Amendment MAJ-1-00, and that the County's action and notification procedures for appealable development legally satisfy the Commission's certification resolution adopted April 12, 2001. I therefore recommend that the Commission concur in this determination.
