SUBJECT: Pacifica LCP Amendment No. 1-99-Minor
Surface Mining and Reclamation Ordinance

On April 14, 2000, the Commission confirmed the Executive Director's designation of the City of Pacifica LCP Amendment No. 1-99 (Surface Mining and Reclamation Ordinance) as minor, with no objection. The findings for this action stated that the LCP amendment would not take effect unless and until the City of Pacifica ("City") adopted a revised ordinance in accordance with three suggested modifications.

On August 25, 2003, the City submitted City Council Ordinance No. 711-C.S., adopting revisions to the City's Surface Mining and Reclamation Ordinance in accordance with the suggested modifications. The City of Pacifica also submitted Resolution No. 37-2003 to submit the Ordinance No. 711-C.S. to the Commission for certification.

The Executive Director has reviewed the ordinance and resolution and has determined that they are in conformance with the modifications suggested by the Executive Director and confirmed by the Commission on April 14, 2000. This notice is to advise interested parties that the Executive Director has determined that LCP Amendment No. 1-99-Minor, as submitted and revised with the documents received on August 25, 2003, is legally adequate to certify this amendment to the LCP.

If a majority of the commissioners present object to the executive director's determination and find that the local government action does not conform to the provisions of the Commission's action to certify the LCP, the Commission shall review the local government's action and notification procedures pursuant to Articles 9-12 as if it were a resubmittal.

The certification of this amendment shall not be deemed final and effective until the City files notice of the certification of the LCP amendment with the Secretary of the Resources Agency for posting and inspection as provided in Public Resources Code Section 21080.5(d)(2)(v).
