DESCRIPTION: **Adoption by the Marin County Board of Supervisors of Ordinance No. 3424, which amended Marin County Code Chapter 6.90 (Bolinas Beach Seasonal Weekend Camping Restrictions) to expand the camping restriction on Bolinas Beach from the summer season "between Friday noon through Monday noon from the second Friday of May through the second Monday of October, inclusive" to year-round "between Friday noon through Monday noon every week of the year" until the second Monday of March 2006.**
