RE: ANNUAL REPORT ON PROTECTING CONSERVATION/OPEN SPACE OTDS

There are approximately 968¹ conservation/open space OTDs required as development mitigation through Commission permit conditions. This report summarizes progress made during 2005 in achieving permanent protection of these easements.

2005 Acceptances

This year staff **successfully negotiated acceptance of 34 offers**; accepting entities included two state agencies, six local governments, as well as three non-profit entities. The Coastal Commission maintains a strong working relationship with the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority, who continues to accept all TDC and Open Space OTDs in the Santa Monica Mountains. No offers expired, and only one new Open Space OTD was recorded in 2005 (CDP# 5-05-020, Hearthside Homes, recorded on 12/05/2005, Orange County).

Attachment A illustrates some of the variety of resources protected through acceptance of these easements. Attachment B includes the entire list of 2005 acceptances.

Data Development

In addition to negotiating 34 acceptances, **staff devoted substantial time researching 224 cases where the status of the recorded documents was unconfirmed**. For 121 of these cases, staff either confirmed the status of the documents or exhausted all research efforts. Staff's research tasks included legal file review, archive permit file review, assessor data research, online searches of county recorder data, as well as visits to four county recorder's offices.

Case Research

During 2005 staff analyzed, documented, and began negotiating numerous case files for future acceptance. However, due to limited resources, staff generally must focus its efforts on OTDs due to expire in the upcoming 6-12 months.
