SUBJECT: **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DETERMINATION** that the action by the City of Half Moon Bay, certifying the City's Local Coastal Program Amendment No. 1-05 (Major), is adequate to effectively certify its local coastal program (for Commission review at its meeting of April 12-14, 2006)

## BACKGROUND

At its December 15, 2005 meeting, the Coastal Commission certified, with suggested modifications, the City of Half Moon Bay Local Coastal Program Amendment 1-05, regarding changes to development standards on certain substandard lots in the Zoning Code/IP. By its action adopting Ordinance No. O-02-06 on February 21, 2006, the City Council has acknowledged and accepted all of the Commission's suggested modifications. The modifications addressed protection of water quality and coastal development permitting requirements and exemptions. The City already has coastal development permit authority over this geographic area and will continue issuing permits consistent with the local coastal program as amended.

As provided for in Section 13544 of the Commission's Code of Regulations, the Executive Director must determine if the action of the City of Half Moon Bay is legally sufficient to finalize Commission review of the LCP amendment. The City's actions have been reviewed and determined to be adequate by the Executive Director. Section 13554 of the Commission's Code of Regulations then requires this determination be reported to the Commission for its concurrence.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Commission <u>CONCUR</u> with the Executive Director's determination as set forth in the attached letter (to be sent after Commission endorsement).

The California Coastal Commission has reviewed the City's Ordinance No. O-02-06 together with the Commission's action of December 15, 2005 certifying City of Half Moon Bay Local Coastal Program Amendment No. 1-05 (Major) pertaining to changes in development standards for certain substandard lot in the Zoning Code/IP. In accordance with Section 13544 of the Commission's Code of Regulations, I have made the determination that the City's actions are legally adequate, and the Commission has concurred at its meeting of April 12-14, 2006.

By its action on February 21, 2006, the City has formally acknowledged and accepted the Commission's certification of the Local Coastal Program Amendment including all suggested modifications.
