SUBJECT: County of Ventura Channel Islands Harbor Public Works Plan Amendment 1-04 (Boating Instruction and Safety Center [BISC] Project): Executive Director's determination that the County's acknowledgement of receipt, acceptance, and agreement with the Commission's certification with suggested modifications is legally adequate. This determination will be reported to the Commission at the August 7, 2008 meeting in Oceanside, California.

On April 9, 2008 the Commission approved Public Works Plan Amendment No. 1-04 to the Channel Islands Harbor Public Works Plan (PWP) submitted by the County of Ventura Harbor Department with suggested modifications. This amendment incorporates the Boating Instruction and Safety Center (BISC) as an allowed use into the County's certified PWP for Channel Islands Harbor.

On May 20, 2008 the Ventura County Board of Supervisors adopted a Resolution (attached) acknowledging receipt of the Commission's certification of LCP Amendment No. MAJ-1-04 on April 9, 2008 and accepting and agreeing to all modifications suggested by the Commission.

Pursuant to Section 13544 of the California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Division 5.5, the Executive Director must determine that the action taken by the County of Ventura acknowledging receipt and acceptance of, and agreement with the Commission's certification of the above referenced PWP amendment with suggested modifications is legally adequate and report that determination to the Commission. The certification shall become effective unless a majority of the Commissioners present object to the Executive Director's determination.

I have reviewed the County's acknowledgement and acceptance of, and agreement with the terms and suggested modifications of PWP Amendment 1-04, as certified by the Commission on April 9, 2008 and find that the County's action is legally adequate to satisfy the terms and requirements of the Commission's certification. I therefore recommend that the Commission concur in this determination.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA
ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT, ACCEPTING AND APPROVING
THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL
CERTIFICATION OF THE CHANNEL ISLANDS HARBOR PUBLIC WORKS
PLAN AMENDMENT No. 1-04 REGARDING THE BOATING INSTRUCTION
AND SAFETY CENTER**

WHEREAS, the Channel Islands Harbor Public Works Plan ("PWP") was certified by the California Coastal Commission on September 19, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura ("Board"), after considering all written and oral testimony, County staff reports and recommendations, approved a PWP amendment at a legally noticed public hearing on October 19, 2004, in order to specifically allow for the construction of a Boating Instruction and Safety Center ("BISC") at the Channel Islands Harbor; and

WHEREAS, the California Coastal Commission, after considering all written and oral testimony, Coastal Commission staff reports and recommendations, approved and conditionally certified Amendment No. 1-04 to the PWP with the 27 modifications and 13 special conditions by a vote of 9 to 3 on April 9, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the California Coastal Commission, on May 7, 2008, adopted Revised Findings for PWP Amendment No. 1-04, including 27 modifications and 13 special conditions by a unanimous vote of the Commissioners who were present and eligible to vote on this matter; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to complete the certification of PWP Amendment 1- 04 by acknowledging receipt of and accepting the modifications and conditions adopted by the California Coastal Commission.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, ORDERED, AND DETERMINED THAT the Board acknowledges receipt of, accepts, and approves of the California Coastal Commission's approval and conditional certification of PWP Amendment No. 1-04, with suggested modifications, on April 9, 2008, in compliance with California Code of Regulations, title 14, sections 13551, subdivision (b) and 13544, subdivision (a).
