SUBJECT: City of Malibu LCP Amendment No. MAJ-1-10 Time Extension to be

heard at the September 15, 2010 Commission Hearing in Eureka.

On January 4, 2010, the City of Malibu submitted an amendment to the Implementation Plan (IP) portion of its certified Local Coastal Program (LCP). The amendment proposes to: (1) add new definitions for categories of slopes and amend Site Plan Review requirements for structures constructed on the different categories of slopes; and (2) modify Table B of the IP to allow lighting of main sports fields at public high schools in the Institutional zone pursuant to a conditional use permit.

On July 22, 2010, the Executive Director determined that the City's amendment submittal was in proper order and legally adequate to comply with the submittal requirements of Coastal Act Section 30510(b). Pursuant to Coastal Act Section 30512 and California Code of Regulations Section 13522, an amendment to the certified IP portion of the LCP must be scheduled for a public hearing and the Commission must take action within 60 days of a complete submittal. The 60th day after filing the complete submittal is September 20, 2010.

Coastal Act Section 30517 and California Code of Regulations Section 13535 (c) state that the Commission may extend for good cause the 60-day time limit for a period not to exceed one year. Commission staff is requesting an extension to the 60-day time limit in order to allow adequate time to review and analyze the amendment. Therefore, staff recommends that the Commission extend the 60-day time limit to act on the City of Malibu LCP Amendment No. MAJ-1-10 for a period not to exceed one year.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Commission vote to extend the deadline for Commission action for one year.

MOTION: I move that the Commission extend the 60-day time limit to act on the

City of Malibu LCP Amendment No. MAJ-1-10 for one year.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends a **YES** vote. An affirmative vote of a majority of the Commission present is needed to pass the motion.
