SUBJECT: **Santa Barbara City College--Public Works Plan Amendment No. 2-12 (Major) Time Extension for May 8-10, 2013 Commission Hearing.**

On December 21, 2012 Santa Barbara City College submitted an amendment to its certified SBCC Public Works Plan (PWP). The proposed amendment would allow for modifications to the existing Sensitive Habitats Map Figure 3.0; the addition of an Outdoor Art Workshop patio adjacent to the Humanities Building, and the addition of a one-story storage room as part of the Humanities Building. On March 28, 2013 the Executive Director determined that the College's amendment submittal was in proper order and legally adequate to comply with the submittal requirements of Coastal Act Section 30605.

Pursuant to Section 30605 of the Coastal Act, any proposed amendment to the certified PWP shall be submitted to, and processed by, the Commission in the same manner as prescribed for amendment of a local coastal program. Pursuant to Section 13371 and Section 13356 (c) of the California Code of Regulations the Executive Director shall set the PWP amendment for a public hearing no later than 60 days from the date on which the application was filed. The 60th day after filing the complete submittal is May 27th, 2013. In order to be heard within this time frame, the amendment would have to be scheduled for the Commission's May 8-10, 2013 meeting.

Coastal Act Section 30517 and California Code of Regulations Section 13535 (c) state that the Commission may extend for good cause any time limit for a period not to exceed one year. Therefore, Commission staff is requesting to extend the 60-day time limit to one year beyond the 60th day after filing the complete submittal in order to allow adequate time to review and analyze the amendment. Staff has consulted with the Santa Barbara City College and it is anticipated that the amendment will be scheduled for either the Commission's June 2013 meeting in Long Beach or July 2013 meeting in Ventura.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Commission vote to extend the deadline for Commission action on Santa Barbara City College Public Works Plan Amendment 2-12 for one year.

MOTION: *I move that the Commission extend the 60 day time limit to act on the Santa Barbara City College Public Works Plan Amendment No. 2-12 for one year.*

RECOMMENDATION Staff recommends a **YES** vote. An affirmative vote of a majority of the Commission present is needed to pass the motion.
