State Coastal Conservancy Meeting Report

January 23, 2014

The Coastal Conservancy approved the following:

South Coast

- 1. a grant of \$200,000 to the City of Solana Beach to reconstruct the <u>Del Mar Shores beach-access stairway</u> at the City's southern end, San Diego County.
- 2. a grant of \$156,250 to the San Diego River Conservancy for <u>San Diego River Trail Planning</u> <u>at Grant Park</u> in the City of San Diego.
- 3. augmentation of the Conservancy's December 2, 2010, authorization to the San Francisco Estuary Institute with an additional \$25,000 for the <u>Historical Ecology Study of North San Diego County Coastal Wetlands</u> project.

Central Coast

- 4. expansion of the scope of the Conservancy's February 14, 2013, authorization with respect to the <u>Circle G Ranch</u> on Carpinteria Creek in Santa Barbara County to include procurement of governmental permits necessary to construct fish passage improvements.
- 5. grants totaling \$119,985 to the City of Watsonville and the University of California to implement three projects focused on the recovery of the <u>Southern sea otter</u>, Santa Barbara through San Mateo counties.

San Francisco Bay Area

6. a grant of \$206,500 to the Muir Heritage Land Trust for design and construction of public access, grazing, and habitat improvements on the contiguous <u>Franklin Canyon and Fernandez</u> <u>Ranch</u> properties in the City of Hercules and in unincorporated Contra Costa County.

Statewide and General

7. grants totaling \$3,078,623 to 20 nonprofit organizations and public agencies for <u>Climate</u> <u>Ready</u> projects that sequester greenhouse gases and/or address the effects of climate change on coastal resources.
