State Coastal Conservancy Meeting Report

March 27, 2014

The Coastal Conservancy approved the following:

South Coast

1. A grant of \$20,700 to the University of Southern California Sea Grant Program to provide training that will build the capacity of coastal communities in the southern California area to understand and plan for the impacts of <u>climate change</u>, Los Angeles County.

San Francisco Bay Area

- 2. Recommendation to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission that 13 resource protection and public access projects be included in the <u>Priority Conservation Area Grant Program</u> for Alameda, Contra Costa, Santa Clara, San Mateo, and San Francisco counties.
- 3. Authorization for the Association of Bay Area Governments to disburse up to \$120,000 of previously granted Conservancy funds to the Napa County Regional Park and Open Space District to construct 0.8 miles of multi-use <u>public trail</u> between the cities of <u>Napa and American Canyon</u>, Napa County.
- 4. adoption of updated San Francisco Bay Area Integrated Regional Water Management Plan.

The next Conservancy meeting is scheduled for May 29, 2014, in Sacramento.
