Proposed Development

Geotechnical investigation of an existing 150-foot long seawall, including excavation of 5 to 6 test borings using small track-mounted drill rig, at 100 Brighton Avenue Bolinas, Marin County.

Executive Director's Waiver Determination

Pursuant to Title 14, Section 13238 of the California Code of Regulations, and based on project plans and information submitted by the Applicant regarding the proposed development, the Executive Director of the California Coastal Commission hereby waives the requirement for a CDP for the following reasons:

The proposed geotechnical investigation is adequately sited and designed to avoid potential impacts to coastal resources, including with respect to public access and water quality. The project will utilize a track-mounted drill rig that will be carried along the top of and adjacent to the sea wall. Test borings at five or six locations, comprising less than a cubic foot of material total, will be excavated and the holes will be backfilled. Lateral public access along the dry sand in front of the seawall will not be impacted during construction. To protect water quality, standard best management practices will be used, including washing, refueling, and/or servicing the drill rig offsite. For the reasons above, the proposed project is consistent with Chapter 3 of the Coastal Act and the certified Marin County Local Coastal Program.

Coastal Commission Review Procedure

This waiver is not valid until the waiver has been reported to the Coastal Commission. This waiver is proposed to be reported to the Commission on December 11, 2015, in Monterey. If four or more Commissioners object to this waiver at that time, then the application shall be processed as a regular CDP application.
