SUBJECT: Request to Waive Time Limit for City of Oceanside LCP Amendment No.

LCP-6-OCN-17-0064-3 (Subdistrict 9) for the Commission Meeting of

March 7-9, 2018

On January 25, 2018, the City of Oceanside Local Coastal Program (LCP) amendment # LCP-6-OCN-17-0064-3 was filed in the San Diego District office. The amendment involves amending the City's Implementation Plan to allow row-style residential development on lots 2,500 sq. ft. and larger within Subdistrict 9 of the Downtown District. The proposed amendment will affect the certified LCP implementation plan only.

Pursuant to Section 30513 of the Coastal Act, the Commission must act on implementation plan amendments within 60 days of filing. Based on the above-cited time limits, the proposed LCP amendment must be scheduled for review by the Commission at the March, 2018 meeting. However, Section 30517 of the Coastal Act and Section 13535(c) of the California Code of Regulations state that the Commission may extend for good cause any applicable time limits for a period not to exceed one year.

Commission staff is requesting the time extension due to insufficient staff time to adequately review the amendment and prepare a recommendation. In addition, the City has been consulted and has indicated the request for postponement is acceptable.

Staff recommends the Commission extend the 60-day time limit for one year. However, it is anticipated that the amendment request will be scheduled for the May or June, 2018 hearings.

## **MOTION**:

I move that the Commission extend the 60-day time limit to act on the City of Oceanside LCP Amendment No. LCP-6-OCN-17-0064-3 for one year.

## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends a <u>YES</u> vote. An affirmative vote of the majority of the Commissioners present is needed to pass the motion.

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
