The Public Watchdogs representatives met with me to express their concern about the decommissioning process

at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS). They also expressed their interest in inviting the

Governor to visit the Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation at SONGS

and their interest in having a conversation with General Counsel and the Lt. Governor on the matter.

Specifically, they indicated their concern about Edison not complying with federal safety nuclear


laws and possible non-compliance with the CCC permit allowing the beachfront Spent Fuel Storage Installation.

Ultimately, the representatives indicated that neither the CCC nor Edison want the nuclear waste to remain on the beach.

### Discussed:

Request to extend an invitation to the Governor to come visit/tour the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI)

Possibility of Special Condition #2 changing as a result of NRC report

Request to have conversation with General Counsel and Lieutenant Governor

Edison's history of noncompliance with Federal nuclear safety laws.

Possible noncompliance of Coastal Commission permit allowing the beachfront ISFSI

Distinction between Coastal Commission CEQA and State Lands Commission CEQA

Common ground: neither Edison, nor the Coastal Commission want nuclear waste to remain on the beach.
