I had a phone call with members of the group "Citizens About Breathable Air" and the Los Cerritos Task Force. Their main ask is that this item not be heard on administrative calendar and instead be scheduled for an entire hearing, so that the issues can be addressed. The group believes that the applicant is seeking to violate the terms of the conditions mandated under CDP 9-18-0395 for the Los Cerritos Wetlands Restoration and Oil Consolidation Project. They also assert that this project violates the intent of the Coastal Commission's Tribal Consultation and Environmental Justice policies. Also, they stated that Application 9-20-0500 does not qualify for approval pursuant to PRC, section 30624. They also believe that ESHA would be disturbed as a result of this project.
