Subject: Certification Review for San Luis Obispo County's Local Coastal Program (LCP) Amendment Number LCP-3-SLO-20-0071-3 (Sign Ordinance)

On January 13, 2021 the Coastal Commission approved San Luis Obispo County LCP Amendment Number LCP-3-SLO-20-0071-3, with modifications. This amendment updates the LCP's sign ordinance, including in relation to public coastal access signage and the protection of visual resources.

By action taken June 8, 2021, San Luis Obispo County adopted the amending LCP suggested modifications (see **Exhibit 1**). The Executive Director has determined that the action taken by the County is legally adequate and that the amended LCP should be certified. The Executive Director recommends that the Commission concur with this determination and that the LCP, as amended, be certified. If the Commission concurs, the amended LCP will be certified as of today's date (i.e., July 8, 2021), and notification of this certification and Commission concurrence will be forwarded to the City.

Executive Director's Recommendation. Staff recommends that the Commission concur with the Executive Director's determination that the actions of San Luis Obispo County in accepting the Commission's certification of LCP Amendment Number LCP-3-SLO-20-0071-3, with modifications, are legally adequate.
