**Subject:** Request to Waive Time Limit for Adoption of Revised Findings for City of San Diego LCP Amendment No. LCP-6-SAN-19-0142-2 (Fiesta Island) for the Commission Meeting of July 7, 2021

---

On June 10, 2021, the Coastal Commission approved, with suggested modifications, the City of San Diego Local Coastal Program (LCP) Amendment No. LCP-6-SAN-19-0142-2. The amendment amended the certified Mission Bay Park Master Plan (Land Use Plan) to update the policies and conceptual development plan for the Fiesta Island segment of Mission Bay Park.

Pursuant to Section 30514.1 of the California Public Resources Code (PRC), the Commission must adopt the findings or provide a written explanation or written notice, as appropriate, required by Sections 30512, 30512.1, 30512.2, and 30513 to support its action certifying the City of San Diego's LCP amendment with suggested modifications no later than 60 days after the date on which that action was taken. Based on the above-cited time limits, the revised findings must be scheduled for review by the Commission at the July 2021 meeting. However, Section 30517 of the Coastal Act and Section 13535(c) of the California Code of Regulations state that the Commission may extend for good cause any applicable time limits for a period not to exceed one year.

Commission staff is requesting the time extension due to insufficient staff time to adequately review the record and prepare the revised findings. Staff recommends the Commission extend the 60-day time limit for one year.

## PROCEDURE

### MOTION:

I move that the Commission extend the 60-day time limit for Commission adoption of revised findings for the City of San Diego LCP Amendment No. LCP-6-SAN-19-0142-2 for one year.

### STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends a YES vote. An affirmative vote of the majority of the Commissioners present is needed to pass the motion.
