This letter is written on behalf of the Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians (“Rincon Band” or “Band”), a federally recognized Indian Tribe and sovereign government. Thank you for consulting with the Band on the above-mentioned project and providing us with the staff report, proposed mitigation measures, and 2019 Cultural Resources Assessment.

We have reviewed the provided documents and agree measures must include archaeological and tribal monitoring, a monitoring report, and protocols for discovery of cultural material and human remains. However, the provided proposed mitigation measures are very problematic and we request a follow-up consultation meeting at your earliest convenience. Please find attached to this letter the first round of requested revisions.

Additionally, we would like to point out that the given time to review the potential impacts associated with this project is too short. We would like to discuss how we can improve consultation between the Rincon Band and your agency.
