

We discussed briefly the problems with the county's proposed changes to their LCP. Koenig explained the proposal from his perspective and indicated that the board wants to hear from the Commrs. He discussed trying to find a way to make a process whereby private property owners might fund other public access projects in return for accommodations for armoring in their areas. He discussed ideas around triggers for SLR and other hazards and agreed that a vulnerability assessment is an important task that needs to get done.
