Good Morning Shahar,

Thank you for calling and discussing the attached staff report for our permit applications yesterday. After reviewing the report we have the following comments/concerns;

On Page 28: Annual Routine Maintenance Activities Report. Under A. PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT

We would like this requirement to be changed from a detailed report to an electronic notification via email to be streamlined with the other regulatory agencies' notifications. Our notifications to other agencies normally include a schedule showing when the maintenance activities will take place in different reaches. The additional information that is requested under this section such as type of proposed maintenance, acreage jurisdictional impacts are already disclosed in our application and we believe will be redundant information.

County does not see an issue with submitting a pre work habitat survey by a qualified biologist as required under section iii. However, we would like 60 day approval time (under section V) to be reduced to 15 days. We believe 15 days is a sufficient time for CCC to respond back and also allow County to more efficiently schedule the maintenance activities. We believe this will also improve the quality of the biological survey since it can be conducted closer to scheduled maintenance time.
