The purpose of a deadline is to ensure that a government agency acts within a reasonable time frame. Adhering to the timeline should prevent backlogs that further prevent the agency from staying on top of its obligations. The admonition in the law that says if the time frame is exceeded the application must be considered approved makes it clear that is the preferred solution. The staff report claims that the extension is needed because the application is complicated but does not provide any specifics. I urge that the application be approved because the extension was left to the last minute and is vague.

The city proposes to spend \$1.5M on a preliminary design of a seawall for Sharp Park after previously requiring the same contractor to treat managed retreat as equivalent to the very destructive "no project."
