Project Description: Application of City of Santa Barbara Waterfront Dept. to implement a comprehensive sediment management program involving dredging and beach nourishment conducted on an as-needed basis with a maximum of 500,000 cu. yds. of material to be dredged annually, beach grooming, installation of lifeguard towers, construction of four seasonal sand berms, maintenance of storm drain outlets, and two fireworks displays at the harbor and waterfront area, including Leadbetter Beach, West Beach, and East Beach, City of Santa Barbara, Santa Barbara County.

The hearing will take place on Friday, May 13, 2022. The commission will hold a series of hearings this day starting at 9:00 am and will move through each agenda item in order. This matter is on the agenda as item number F16a on May 13, 2022.
