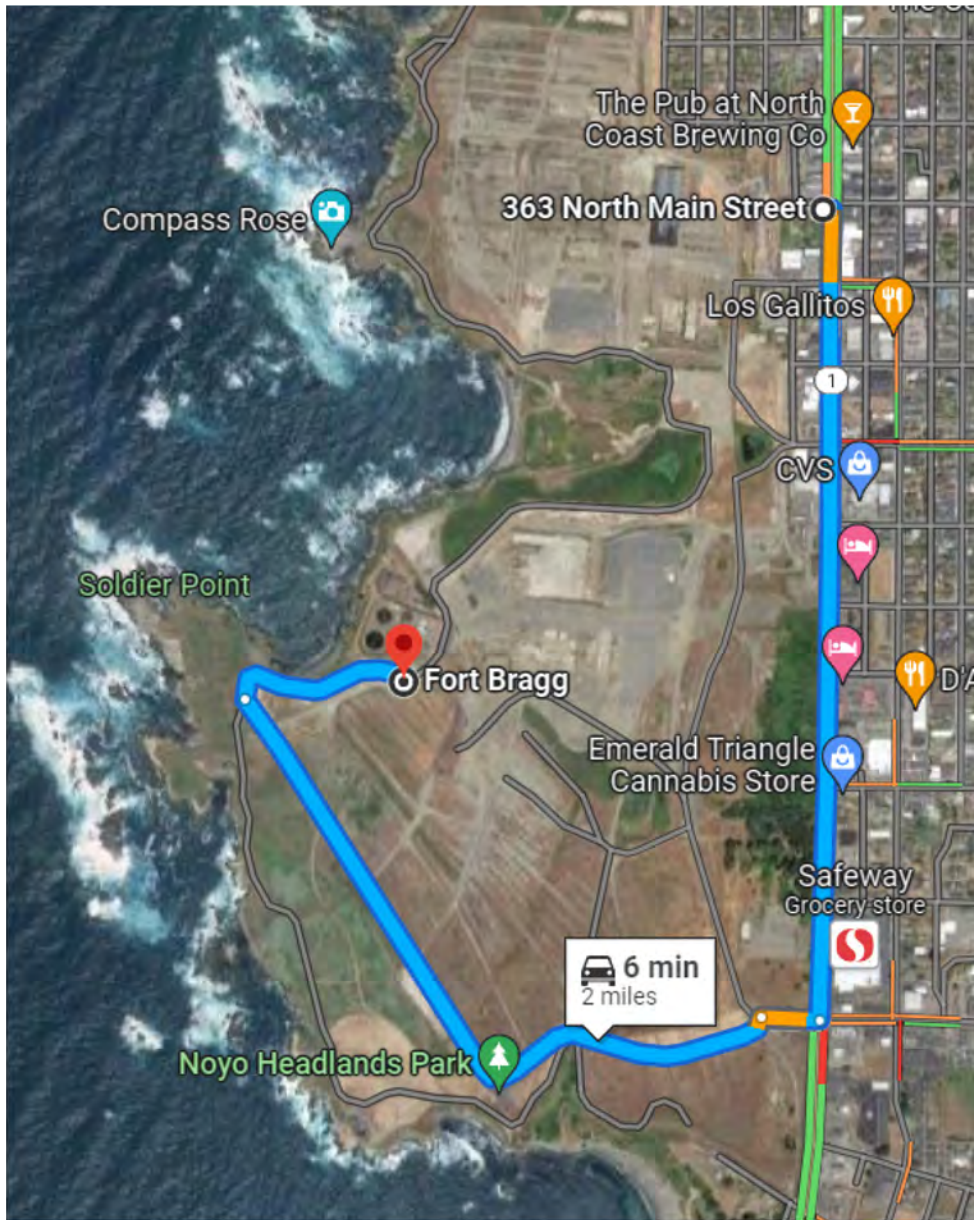

Driving Directions

Fort Bragg Town Hall to Stop 1

- From Town Hall, head south on N. Main Street towards Cypress Street
- Turn right at Cypress Street
- Turn right onto Jere Melo Way (runway/airstrip)
- Destination will be on the right (red marker on below map)



Stop 1 to Stop 2

- From Stop 1 head back out (southbound) along runway/airstrip
- Park at Stop 2, Noyo Headlands Park parking lot (green marker on above map)

Stop 2 to Stop 3

- From Stop 2 head out (eastbound) W. Cypress St. towards S. Main St.
- Turn right onto S. Main Street/South St.
- Turn left onto N. Harbor Dr. and follow to Stop 3
- Stop 3: parking on North Harbor Drive behind Noyo Fishing Center and then walk to Noyo Center's Slack Tide Cafe
