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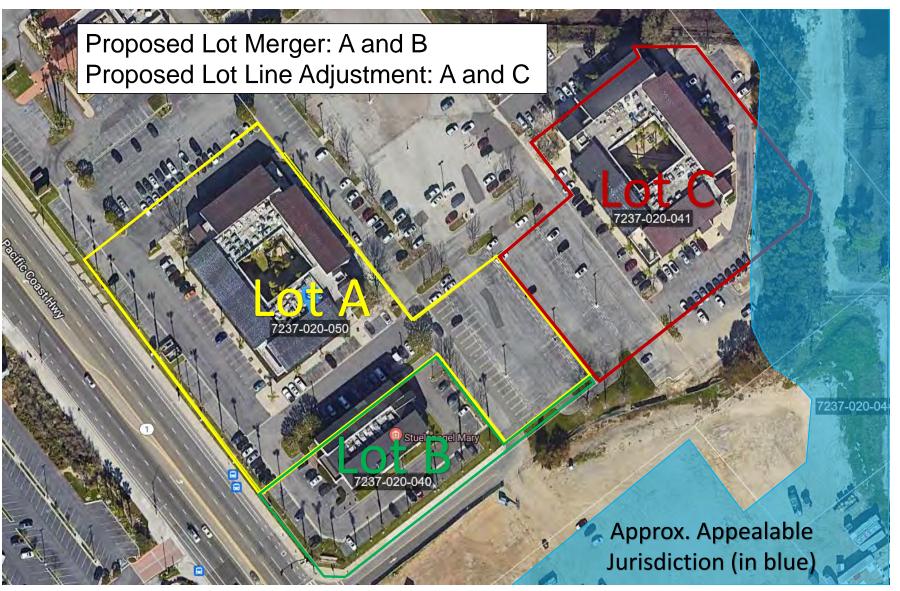
Exhibit 1 - Vicinity Map and Project Site

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LANDSCAPE DESIGN NARRATIVE

The design of the landscape for Long Beach Marketplace takes inspiration from the channels and estuaries of the adjacent Los Cerritos wetlands. Landscape elements meant to emulate the natural forms provide movement through the spaces as well as celebrate the surrounding area that the SEASP intends to protect and enhance. All planting on site will be chosen from the Appendix D of the SEASP despite a small portion of the site being outside the 500' wetland boundary limit for a seamless transition to the surrounding natural areas. Our only exception is minimal highlight planting at the South Gateway corner and the street trees along PCH - outside the boundary limit and chosen from the Long Beach Street Tree List.

Paseo / Fire Lane

A stamped concrete fire lane provides public access with benches, walkway, and 6' landscape buffer

PCH Open Space

The landscape along Pacific Coast Highway is intended for public use with a 6' wide sidewalk and planting on both sides for buffer from the street and project building. Interpretative signage to be determined in coordination with City Planning will be placed along the walk.

Courtyard 1

This courtyard provides full access to the public with a passive landscape concept. A seat wall with picnic table & bench has been located just off the public walk for place to sit and eat lunch. The rest of the courtyard space will be open turf and planting.

Courtyard 2

Surrounded by amenities and leasing, this courtyard has a more active approach. Adjacent the clubroom residents can enjoy outdoor dining and a fire pit. A patio spills out from the interior co-work & lobby space for an outdoor lounge and/or work experience.

Retail Plaza

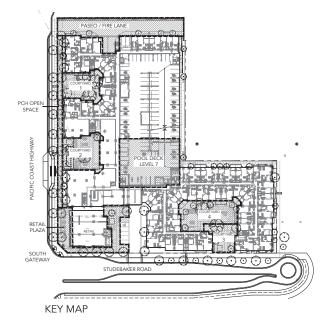
The retail plaza highlights the prominent corner of the project site and South Long Beach Gateway through features such as public art, water fountain, enhanced paving materials, seat walls & furniture, and planting. Street trees are pulled back from the corner to emphasize the enhanced building retail corner.

Courtyard 3 & 4

As a mixed active courtyard concept, walkways thoughtfully divide the courtyard into smaller outdoor rooms and planting areas. These outdoor spaces consist of built-in lounge, fire pits, games, outdoor kitchen, shade structure, small recreation turf, and other loose furniture.

Pool Deck

The roof deck landscape design completes the natural forms concept of the project by bringing the wavy pattern to features on the 7th level. Various forms of seating with lounge and cabanas face the pool with raised planters defining the different spaces. Centered on the pool is an outdoor shade pavilion with a fire pit lounge, games, a media wall, and grill counter. Ample seating is provided through built-in banquet style and furniture. To the west extends a coastal viewing area with lounge seating and fire tables.

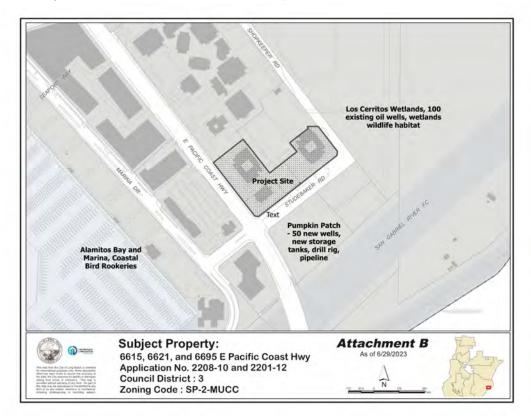

This Lot Line Adjustment should not be approved by the California Coastal Commission

- The sole purpose of dividing this property into two parcels is to deny the right of the public to appeal CP VI Marketplace LLC/Carmel Partner's development project at 6615, 6621, and 6695 East Pacific Coast Highway to the California Coastal Commission.
- 2. The Project Area for the proposed development as described in the EIR and as approved by the City of Long Beach, lies within 100 feet of the Los Cerritos Wetlands, therefore the Project itself is appealable to the Coastal Commission (see map).
- 3. It is critical that the Coastal Commission not allow projects, or project areas to be excluded from public and Coastal Commission oversight, especially when there is clear evidence that it is the intention of a developer to do so.
- 4. We further request that the impacts of the proposed Project itself on the Los Cerritos Wetlands and on our community be taken into consideration, and not excluded from a discussion on the lot line adjustment. Piecemealing property in order to avoid accountability is not that different from arbitrarily restricting what can be considered in the decision making process. This matter is not merely about a line, it is at the heart of coastal protection.
