Subject: **Request to Waive Time Limit for City of San Diego LCP Amendment No. LCP-6-SAN-23-0013-1 (2022 Land Development Code Update) for the Commission Meeting of July 12-14, 2023.**

---

On May 11, 2023, the City of San Diego Local Coastal Program (LCP) Amendment No. LCP-6-SAN-23-0013-1 was filed in the San Diego District office. The amendment involves the City's 2022 package of 84 amendments to the Land Development Code as part of their annual process to identify areas of the code that can be streamlined, corrected, or brought up to date with state and federal law.

Pursuant to Section 30513 of the Coastal Act, the Commission must act on implementation plan amendments within 60 working days of filing. Based on the above-cited time limit, the proposed LCP amendment must be scheduled for review by the Commission at the July 12-14, 2023, meeting. However, Section 30517 of the Coastal Act and Section 13535(c) of the California Code of Regulations state that the Commission may extend for good cause any applicable time limits for a period not to exceed one year.

Commission staff is requesting the time extension due to insufficient staff time to adequately review the amendment and prepare a recommendation. In addition, the City has been consulted and has indicated the request for postponement is acceptable.

Staff recommends the Commission extend the 60-day time limit for one year.

## PROCEDURE

### MOTION:

I move that the Commission extend the 60-day time limit to act on the City of San Diego LCP Amendment No. LCP-6-SAN-0013-1 for one year.

### STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends a YES vote. An affirmative vote of the majority of the Commissioners present is needed to pass the motion.
