SUBJECT: **ADDENDUM TO ITEM W7a, Notice of Impending Development UCS-NOID-0003-24 (Facilities Management Site Demolition) FOR THE COMMISSION MEETING OF Wednesday, June 12, 2024**

I. CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED

One letter was received from Leslie Purcell following publication of the staff report. The letter raised concerns about the potential for monarch butterfly use of the non-native trees at the subject site, and requested that if the trees are used by monarch butterfly for roosting, that a condition is added for protection. The subject NOID includes the minor trimming and removal of non-native vegetation and trees that are less than 6-inches in diameter at breast height. The subject vegetation is located within an existing developed area of the site, and not within ESHA, wetland, or open space areas. Biological surveys of the subject site confirm that the vegetation proposed for removal is not monarch butterfly habitat, and as such, additional protective measures are not recommended. This letter has been included in the correspondence document posted with the staff report on the Commission's online agenda.
